INSTALLATION GUIDE

The homeowner should hire an installation team and pay for the labor to ensure the safe and convenient installation of the bathtub.

Sequence and method of installation:

A. Before installation:

- Keep the product in its original packaging and store it indoors, away from outdoor exposure. High temperatures can create high humidity inside the PE film layer, causing discoloration and peeling of the bathtub enamel.
- Do not remove the packaging before installation.

B. During installation:

- Install the bathtub as the last step when the room is already finished to avoid clashes with other construction teams.
- The bathtub should still be kept in its original packaging while being transported into the room for installation.
- Keep the product in its packaging when carrying it into the room to avoid scratching the door or other objects.
- In case the size of the door is not suitable for bringing the bathtub inside, it is possible to remove the pallet in front of the door and place the bathtub on a trolley to bring it in.
- Determine the installation position of the bathtub and place it in position.
- Use a soft cloth to place beside the bathtub, then tilt the bathtub and connect the drainage pipe under the bottom of the bathtub to the floor drain.
- Bring the bathtub to a level position."

C. Important notes:

- Do not fix the bathtub base with cement; do not apply direct force to the back of the bathtub; do not lift the bathtub by the handrail (if applicable) as it may cause damage.
- Do not place heavy objects on the surface of the bathtub, and avoid getting cement or paint on the bathtub surface.
- Avoid contact between the bathtub and cleaning agents containing hydrochloric acid or other corrosive substances. In case of contact, rinse immediately with water.
- It is necessary to have a plan to protect the product during installation before it is put into use. Alert the construction teams in the bathtub area not to place any objects or tools inside the bathtub that could scratch, damage, or dirty the product during the construction process.
- Do not wear shoes inside the bathtub or place ladders, chairs, etc., inside during installation.
- Do not expose the bathtub to open flames, welding sparks, cigarette ash, etc.
- Ensure an adequate number of people to handle the bathtub. Do not drag the bathtub on the floor to avoid causing damage.
- Scratches and damages that occur during installation and use are beyond the scope of our warranty coverage.

SAFETY DURING USE

- Do not let children bathe alone in the bathtub to avoid injuries from falls.
- When the bathtub is filled with water, do not use electrical devices inside or near the bathtub to prevent electric shocks.
- Stop using immediately if the bathtub is cracked or broken, as it can cause injuries. Please notify our company; if the product is still within the warranty period and the cause of the defect is due to the product itself, we will fulfill our responsibility to repair or replace it.
- Do not sit or slide on the inclined surface of the bathtub. It can easily damage the bathtub and result in slipping injuries.
- Do not apply external force to the bathtub or allow heavy and hard objects to fall into the bathtub. It can easily cause the bathtub to crack, break, and lead to water leakage. Check the water temperature before stepping into the bathtub to avoid scalding.
- Do not step on or use the handrail of the bathtub for exercise. It can be slippery and cause injuries.
- Do not use the handrail to lift or move the bathtub. The handrail is not designed to withstand force, and using it for lifting may result in breakage and the bathtub falling, causing foot pain and damage to the bathtub.
- Do not stand on the upper edge of the bathtub during installation and use. It can be slippery and cause injuries. In cold weather conditions, pay attention to the following: Completely drain the water from the bathtub. If water is not completely drained, it may cause the accessories (bottom, pipes, etc.) to become too cold and damaged, resulting in water leakage

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE AND MAINTENANCE

- When using, please drain cold water first, then add hot water. Draining hot water from the beginning can damage the bathtub surface and drain accessories, even causing surface deterioration.
- We recommend using regular soap and a soft cloth for cleaning, and regularly maintaining the bathtub. If dirt remains on the bathtub surface, it will be harder to clean. Avoid using industrial cleaning agents, Duck, Vim, or any strong equivalent cleaning agents.
- Be careful not to let heavy, hard, or sharp objects fall into the bathtub.
- Do not extinguish lit cigarettes on the bathtub surface as it will leave burn marks.
- Avoid placing hair clips or items prone to rusting in the bathtub to prevent difficulties in cleaning rust stains.
- The cleanliness of the bathtub depends on the water quality; therefore, regular bathtub cleaning is necessary.
- The drain trap should be cleaned thoroughly after each use. Otherwise, hair and other debris may accumulate, reducing drainage efficiency. Do not pour paint, oil, strong acids, strong alkalis, organic solvents (acetone, dimethylbenzene, chlorophan, etc.) into the bathtub.
